

## Attaching a certificate to an education credit

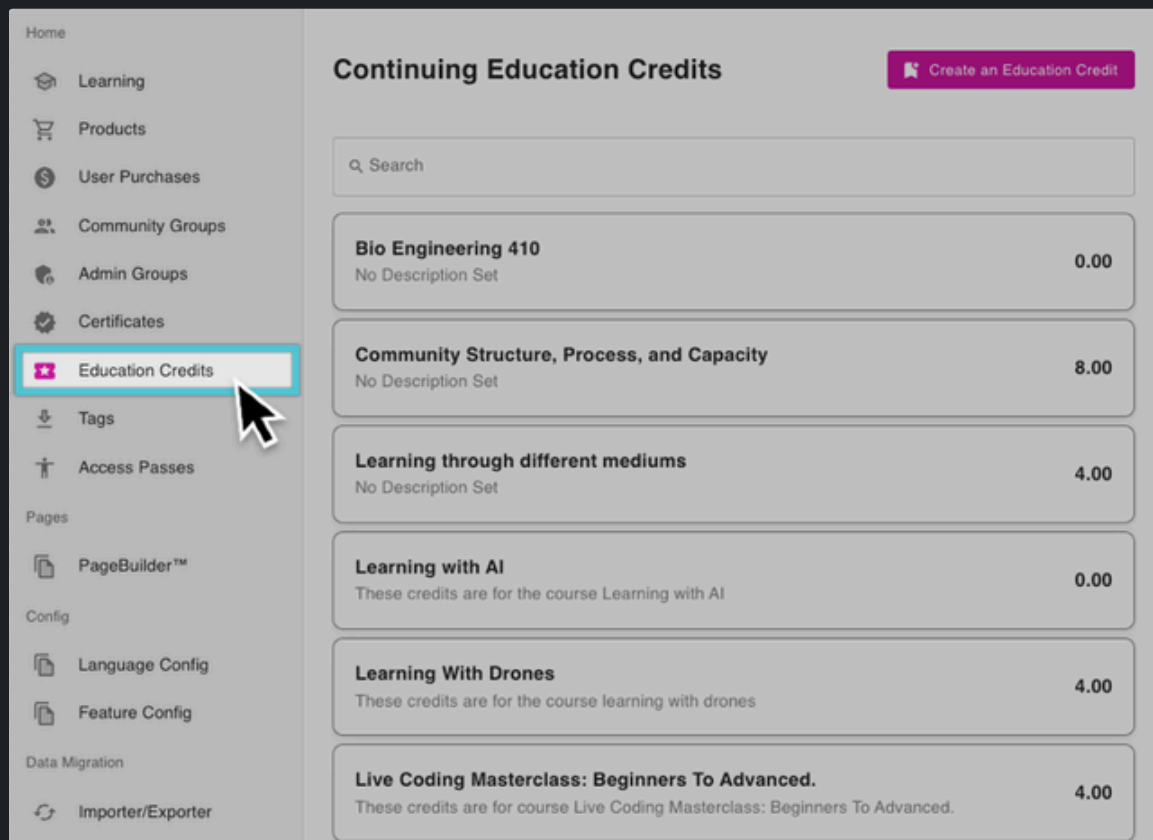
**⚠️** A note for Site Admins: Full access to Das admin is coming soon! Check back later for updates.

Admins can add certificates to courses using the Education Credit (EC) section of Das admin. As long as a certificate is attached to an EC, depending on how many pieces of content are attached to that EC, learners can view and download the Certificate after completing the course or when they claim the EC.

**ℹ️** To attach a Certificate to an Education Credit you must first have built a certificate template to attach. Learn more about creating certificates.

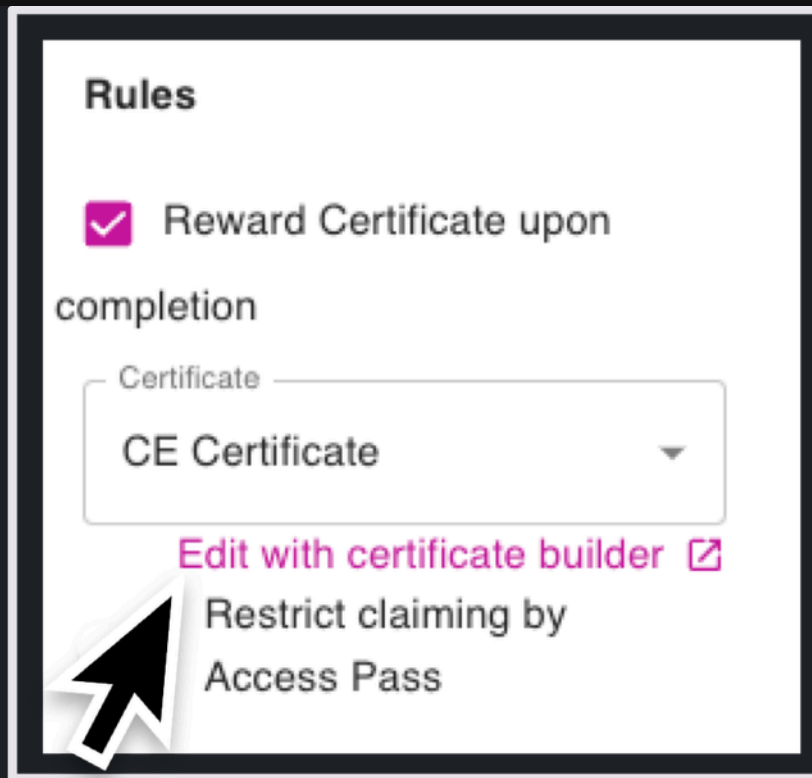
