Rotator modules

Rotators cycle through different content on your site, displaying multiple pieces in a single space and potentially increasing exposure.

Creating a Rotator module on a page.

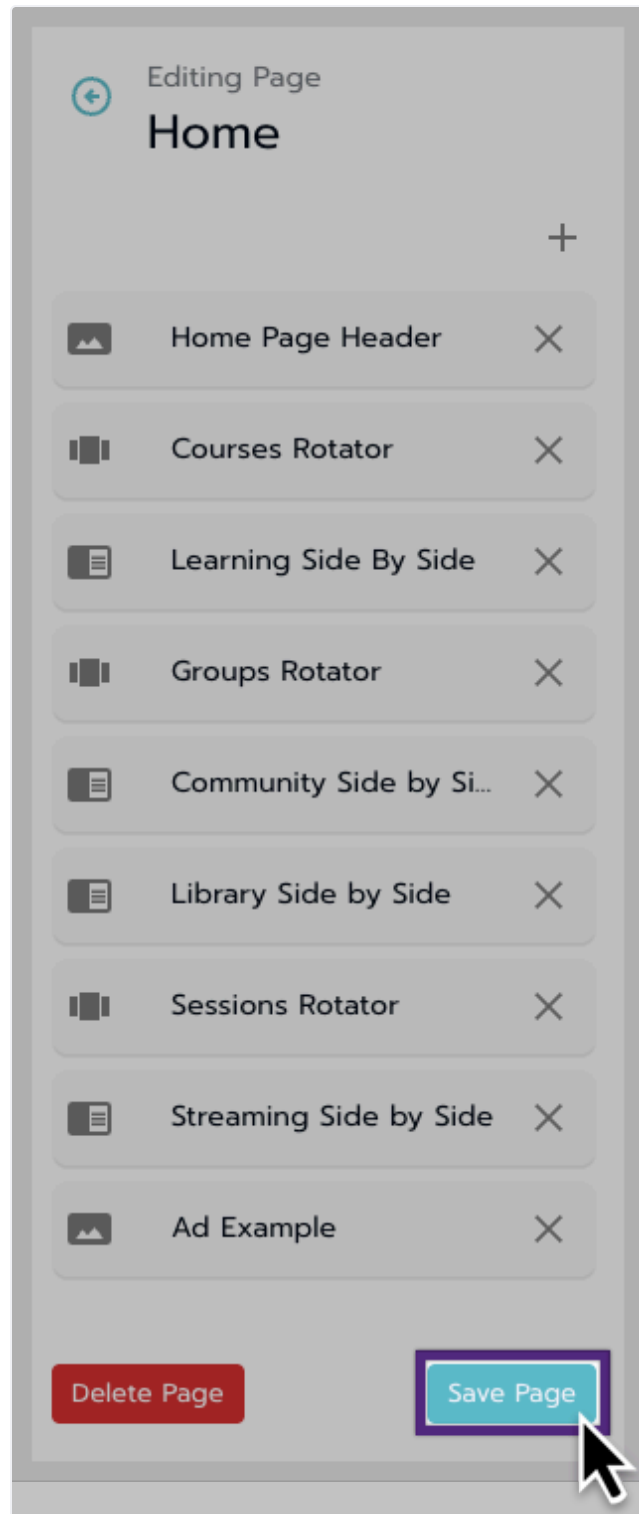
Creating a rotator



1. Click **+** at the top of the sidebar and select **Rotator**.
2. Select the new **Rotator** item that appeared in the menu.
3. Give the rotator a unique **Name** so that you can identify it later. The name doesn't appear on the site page.
4. Fill out the fields listed below to customize your rotator.

Saving your changes

-  Remember to save your page updates when you are done editing any module to avoid losing progress by selecting the **Save Page** button.

Pull content into the module with this field:




Content-Type	<p>This is how you choose which content type is pulled into the module. Select the content type from the drop-down menu.</p> <p> Rotator content is enabled for Courses and Groups at this time. You might see other options as they are in progress, but the option for speakers is not valid. This was last reviewed 28 Mar 2024.</p>

Tailor the module's appearance and user interaction through these fields:


Design options



Title	Add a Title that will show above the module.
Arrows	Check this box to show arrows.
Dots	Check this box to show dots.
Show Title	<p>Check box: Default On.</p> <p>When unselected, the title you give the rotator will not show on the page</p>
Show Pause	Check this box to show the pause button for accessibility.
Variant	<p>Select the module shape from the drop-down menu. For example, Circular, rounded, or square. Note that a square can be a rectangle; it just means it has hard corners instead of rounded corners.</p>
Text align	<p>Options for: Center, Left and Right. Align the titles of each slide (not the module title). We recommend using Left for most content but Center for speakers (because they are circular).</p>

Slide width and height	Input 355 (width) x 200 (height) for a standard 16:9 ratio image. This corresponds to the image size (800 x 450) that we request from clients for most rectangular images
Spacing	10 is the standard recommended spacing.
Slide title	Check this box to see the title of the content beneath the slide.
Slide description	Check this box to show the content's preview text beneath the slide.
Show Progress	 For courses only, check this box to show the progress indicator in the corner of the Tile.
